
FIS Sector Taxonomy Guide





The Syntax Sector Taxonomy is an industry classification system developed to organize global, publicly-listed companies. Unlike legacy classification systems that group companies only by their primary business segment, Syntax leverages its proprietary Functional Information System (FIS*) technology to capture the attributes of a company's business models and its underlying product lines. Companies have different business models for different product lines. With FIS, one company can be associated with multiple, highly-specific industry groups based on the attributes of their individual product lines. For example, Amazon is often classified as only a Consumer Discretionary company. This does not account for its other product lines, such as Amazon Web Services (Cloud Services) or Whole Foods (Supermarkets), or the unique business characteristics and risks of each product line.

The Syntax Sector Taxonomy is a rules-based, flexible and precise alternative to legacy classification systems and supports five levels of granular drill-downs, enabling investors to pinpoint business characteristics. Its structure was established to more effectively diversify index populations, and therefore, has more substantial top-level sectors, such as Financials (which includes Banking, Insurance and Real Estate), Energy (which includes Oil & Gas and Utilities), and Industrials (which includes Materials, Components, Equipment and Services).

Additionally, it differentiates between Information Tools companies (which provide the hardware and software used to manipulate information resources), Information companies (whose products and services directly provide information resources to customers), as well as Consumer companies (including Personal Products, Apparel, Home & Office Products, and Transportation) and Food companies.



Level 1 - Sector

1_Financials

Companies that provide financial services, such as banking, lending, investments, and insurance, including real estate owners and operators

2_Energy

Companies that produce, transport, or market energy resources

3_Industrials

Companies involved in producing raw materials, manufacturing goods or equipment, or providing services involving goods or equipment, such as shipping and construction

4_Information Tools

Companies involved in developing software or manufacturing technology hardware

5_Information

Companies that provide information resources. Includes knowledge products and services, media, telecommunications, websites, and information-oriented business services, such as consulting

6_Consumer Products and Services

Companies that manufacture or retail consumer goods, or provide consumer services

7_Food

Companies involved in producing, distributing, or retailing food products

8 Healthcare

Companies involved in the healthcare industry, including pharmaceuticals, healthcare providers and companies that provide equipment or services to healthcare providers
